

Clubs:

The staff of SVHS/JCIB strives to meet the needs of all students by agreeing to sponsor clubs and organizations in an attempt to provide opportunities for study, competition, and community service for our students.

- AJAS/JCIB - The AJAS is also known as the Quanta Science Club (IB)/Science Olympiad. It is a competitive science organization for IB students.
- Art Club -The Art club participates in art showings around Birmingham and Jefferson County.
- Beta Club -The Beta Club is an organization that promotes the ideals of character, service, and leadership. The student must apply to join.
- Biology/Ecology Club - The Biology/Ecology Club is an organization that serves the school and community with an emphasis on preservation of the environment. This club helps clean up local areas.
- Book Club - The Book Club promotes reading; the club reads a book a month and then discusses the book at every meeting.
