

Lockers:

Personal lockers are provided for storage of books, notebooks, and lunches. All ninth and tenth grades students are required to have a locker. Lockers are school property and leased to students. They are not intended to be strong boxes for money or other valuable items. Lockers are provided for student convenience, and **the student, not the school, is responsible for items lost or stolen from them.**

No contraband of any kind is to be stored in a locker. Administrators will search lockers at any time that they have reasonable cause to believe something harmful to students is inside the locker. Police canine units will also be used to search if necessary.

The administration reserves the right to search lockers at any time based on reasonable cause.

Students must keep their lockers locked, not inform other students of their combinations, not make marks on locks to indicate the combination, and not allow other people to use their lockers. Broken or out of order lockers are to be reported to the office. Lockers must be cleaned out prior to the last day of final exams each year.

To change lockers, approval must be secured from the office. Changing of lockers without permissions is a disciplinary violation, and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken. **Students may not share lockers (Class I offense). No stickers, decals, etc., may be placed on the exterior or interior of lockers.**

Students may place items that are easily removable without damage to the lockers may be placed on the inside. **No items with adhesive or glue backing should be placed in lockers.** Students will be responsible for paying for any damage they do to their lockers or to any other locker.
