

Parking:

The SVHS/JCIB/SVTA campus is private property owned by Jefferson County Board of Education. All vehicles regularly parked on campus must be registered with the office and have a current Shades Valley High School decal. Students must be in at least the tenth grade and present a valid AL driver's license in order to purchase a parking registration decal. Students who might drive one of several cars to school, **must register all vehicles. No student may use another student's decal.** No student may use a motor vehicle that belongs to another student without the consent of the owner. No freshmen or other unlicensed driver may register a car.

Students are expected to adhere to parking regulations, drive responsibly, and honor speed limits; **adhere to all attendance policies regarding arrival and dismissal**; otherwise, a student driver will not be permitted to bring their cars to school. **The speed limit is 10 mph. SVHS/JCIB is not responsible for cars being stolen or vandalized while on the school grounds.** Students who drive vehicles on campus must exercise extreme care in their operation. **Unsafe driving practices will result in the revoking of parking privileges.**

The administration reserves the right to search student vehicles at any time based on reasonable cause. Students who abuse parking regulations may be subject to disciplinary action and have their parking privileges revoked.

Parking registration decals cost \$25.00 and will be sold at registration. The decal must be visible at all times so that the parking registration number can be easily read. Cars without a visible parking decal are subject to being towed. The \$25.00 parking registration does not provide for parking lot security.

Cars must be parked in parking spaces only with visible decals; they are not to be parked around islands, curbs, or in any unmarked areas. Students are not allowed to park in the faculty parking spaces marked in red.

Violations of the rules listed above can also result in the student receiving administrative disciplinary action.

Students who have six (6) tardies to first block during a term will have their parking privileges revoked for the remainder of the term.

Compulsory School Attendance as Related to Student Drivers License:

The Department of Safety will be notified when a student has more than 10 consecutive or 15 cumulative days of unexcused absence during a single semester. **Alabama Legislative Act 93-368.** The purpose of 93-368 is to require school attendance standards as a prerequisite for a driver's license of learner's permit for the operation of a motor vehicle. School attendance standards are met by enrollment in a school.

Requirements of the above Act include:

- Verification of enrollment status by appropriate school personnel on Part I of the Student

Enrollment/Exclusion Status form.

- Notification to the Department of Public Safety when a student has more than 10 consecutive or 15 cumulative days of unexcused absences during a single semester.
- Exemption for students due to circumstances beyond the control of the student.
- Implementation of appeals process.
